ANNUAL REPORT (2020-21)

We are a legally registered non-governmental organization working for the welfare of the rural poor in Anantapur District of Andhra Pradesh for the past 24 years. The organization is registered under the Indian Societies Registration Act' 21st of 1860, Foreign Contribution Regulation Act' 1976, u/s 12AA and u/s 80G of the Income Tax Act' 1961. The activities of the organization during the year 2020-21 are as follows.

Residential Primary School for Scheduled Castes:

This school has been running exclusively for the poorest of the poor Scheduled Caste children with the grant assistance of the Union Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment from the year 1995-96. This school provides primary education with all necessary amenities like residence, food, uniform, books, stationery, play material, bedding material etc., at free of cost. 25 students (Male-17 & Female-08) successfully completed primary education and got admitted into 6th class. The roll of the students during the year 2020-21 is as follows.

Due to continuous effect of Corona virus, we could not run the school, because State Government did not permit to open and run any type of residential schools especially primary schools during the year 2020-21. All the students were promoted to next class without conducting examinations. We distributed educational material like note books, text books, slates, pens, pencils, copy writing

books etc., to our students and instructed the parents to look after their children safe at home in their villages.

COVID-19 QUARANTINE CENTRE:

Our school was handed over to the State Government from 3rd May' 2020 to 15th June' 2020 to maintain Quarantine Centre for migrated laborers who returned from Maharashtra and Karnataka. We maintained hygiene well in the centre and provided blankets, clothes, napkins, safe drinking water etc., to all the residents during this period. We also arranged medical counseling classes to the residents of quarantine centre.

NOVEL CORONA AWARENESS PROGRAMME:

The programme was conducted from August' 2020 which was intended to bring awareness in the public to combat Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19). Our team of volunteers along with the personnel of local Health, Panchayatraj and Revenue Departments distributed 20,000 pamphlets in the entire residential area of Gorantla town and surrounding villages. All the precautions like washing hands with soaps & sanitizers, using mosques, consuming nutritious food which improves immunity, maintaining social distance etc., were printed in the pamphlets and the same was propagated through the mike system.
